

## **Evergreen Speedway's June 15 Results**

*For Immediate Release (June 16):* The weather cooperated with the sun appearing from the cloud bank just as the cars took to the track for an afternoon of practice prior to the Annual BECU Father's Day and Reunion Night at the Races. Evergreen Speedway in Monroe, WA is celebrating its 65<sup>th</sup> year of operation this season. 'The Super Speedway of the West' added five new names to the list of the 60 best drivers who have competed there over the previous 60 years. Gaylon Stewart, Matt Hein, Quenton Borreson, Roger Drake and Lane Sundholm.

Tyler Tanner (Auburn, WA) won the NASCAR Whelen All American Series Speedway Chevrolet Super Late Model 65-lap main. It was Tanners 4<sup>th</sup> win in 4-starts on the 3/8-mile oval and he continues as the season leader in the points. Tanner grabbed the lead on lap 28 and was never seriously challenged after taking the lead from Mike Holden (Snohomish, WA). Holden finished fourth behind third-place Doni Wanat (Woodinville, WA). Jeff Knight (Monroe, WA) finished a strong second.

The winner of the Street Stock main on the 3/8-mile oval was Ted Lingren (Lake Stevens, WA). Lingren celebrated his first ever podium finish as the winner. Lingren's win was done in solid fashion as he took the lead on lap 6 of the 30-lap main. Second place driver was Shane Sawin (Snohomish, WA). In third, it was Steve Ptacek (Kirkland, WA).

Foster Press Mini-Stock winner after 30-laps was Leanne Tanner (Auburn, WA). Tanner who used to run Mini-Stocks years ago (30 years ago was her last win 1989) under her maiden name Sundholm. After a substantial hiatus from racing, Tanner returned to action this season. She is the wife of former NASCAR NW Tour champion Kelly Tanner and mom of last season's Evergreen Speedway NASCAR Super Late Model champion and current points leader Tyler Tanner. BTW she is also the only woman to run in the former NASCAR NW Tour. A late restart of the 30-lap main Tanner survived the challenge applied by second place Colton Price (Everett, WA) and third place finisher Jonah Vick (Arlington, WA).

The Interstate Batteries Hornets held their 30-lap main with Cole Rarden (Granite Falls, WA) taking the win. Starting 17<sup>th</sup> Rarden had the lead by lap 12. The second-place spot was held by Brenden Therriault (Lake Stevens, WA) and third went to Mike Jensen (Arlington, WA).

Winning the Junior Hornet main was Haley Constance (Snohomish, WA) daughter of Super Late Model and NW Tour veteran Joe Constance. Equaling her dad Shane Sawin's second place finish in the street stock main, Marissa Sawin (Snohomish, WA) finished second and third went to Dylan Frazier.

Next up at Evergreen Speedway is the Annual '90 Minutes of FEAR' presented by BEW-NECA Union on Saturday, June 22. It is 90-minutes of figure 8 race cars challenging the world's most dangerous intersection. The Outlaw Super F8's, Super Stock F8's and Stinger 8's all in action. Plus, the Washington Midget Racing Association cars will be on the 3/8-mile oval. Adding to the night's activities are the Pro 4 Trucks and the popular Youth Hornets.
